COURSE MAY BE WALKED FROM 2PM SATURDAY 16th SEPTEMBER.

You will jump one round over show jumps and go directly over the cross country course. (XC will be 13 to 15 jumps)

Classes commence at 10am

Class 1 - 55cms - (over a shortened XC course) Open

Class 2 - 70cm – Open

Class 3 - Pairs (SJ 70cms / XC can jump any height)

Class 4 - 80cm - Restricted - Combination not to have won 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any hunter trial or ODE at this height or above.

Class 5 - 80cms – Open

Class 6 - 90cms - Open

Class 7 - 1m - Open

**Entry £20 per class, DW(NM)PC Members £15, (in advance only), except for pairs which will be £30 (must be received by 9th September)
Entry on day £25 per class, Pairs £40 (If spaces available)**

Rosettes awarded to 8th place

There is a £2 fee (for the day) per rider for contribution to ambulance / first aid cover.

* **Numbers** will be provided in A4 format for insertion into bibs. Competitors to bring their own bibs. Hats & body protectors must be checked by Tack Steward before numbers are given out.

RULES:

1. Riders having had 3 refusals at any one fence will be asked to leave that jump immediately, but may proceed around the rest of the course and must give way to other riders.
2. There will be an optimum time for the show jumping course and an optimum time for the cross country course.
3. Pairs – SJ will be jumped individually, XC jumps designated (dressing fences) must be jumped as a pair and penalties will be added unless the horse's heads are in line.
4. The decision of the judges and organisers is final.
5. No outside assistance (except from officials) will be allowed whilst on the course.
6. **ALL competitors must wear BODY PROTECTORS at BETA 2009 Level 3 standard AND ARMBANDS.** A limited number of arm bands will be available to purchase on the day at a cost of £4.
7. **ALL competitors MUST wear an approved hat** with a flexible peak.
8. Long hair must be tied up so fence judges can clearly see numbers.
9. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
10. All horses must be at least 4 years old.
11. No more than 3 rounds permitted per horse.

There will be a Tack Check to include rules 6 & 7
