- Class 4 PC70** Dressage: PC Introductory Dressage Test
Fences approx 65-70cm
- Class 5 50-55** Dressage: PC Walk Trot Dressage Test XC on Shortened main course
Fences approx 50-55cm
- Class 6 30-35** Dressage: PC Walk Trot Dressage Test (XC in rope arena) approx 30-35cm

Please pay particular attention to rules on Vaccinations, Hats, Body Protectors & Medical Armbands

1. All non Pony Club competitors are **NOT** covered by The Pony Club insurance and **MUST** have their own third party cover. The Tetcott & South Tetcott Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
2. **New rules on Vaccinations.** All horses/ponies taking part must have a current vaccination against Equine Influenza. This comprises as a minimum 2 primary vaccinations not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart. Following this a first booster not less than 150 days and not more than 215 days after the 2nd primary vaccination. Subsequent boosters must be given not more than 1 year from first booster. No horse or pony will be allowed on the field if it does not have its course of 2 primary vaccinations. Please bring your passports with you to collect your numbers.
3. If wearing the “**Woof Wear Locking**” form of body protector, please hand the key, in an envelope marked with their name & number to the paramedic before they go cross country. It is their responsibility to collect it afterwards
4. Refunds of entries will only be given on production of a Doctor’s or Vet’s certificate.
5. No outside assistance may be given in classes 1 - 4
6. If the class is oversubscribed riders will be restricted to two horse entries if you wish to enter more than 2 horses please contact the entry secretary.
7. Competitors and families may not approach the scorer’s domain. Any queries must be directed to the organiser. Objections must be lodged in writing with £20.00 deposit.
8. The judges’ decision is final.
9. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
10. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
11. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
